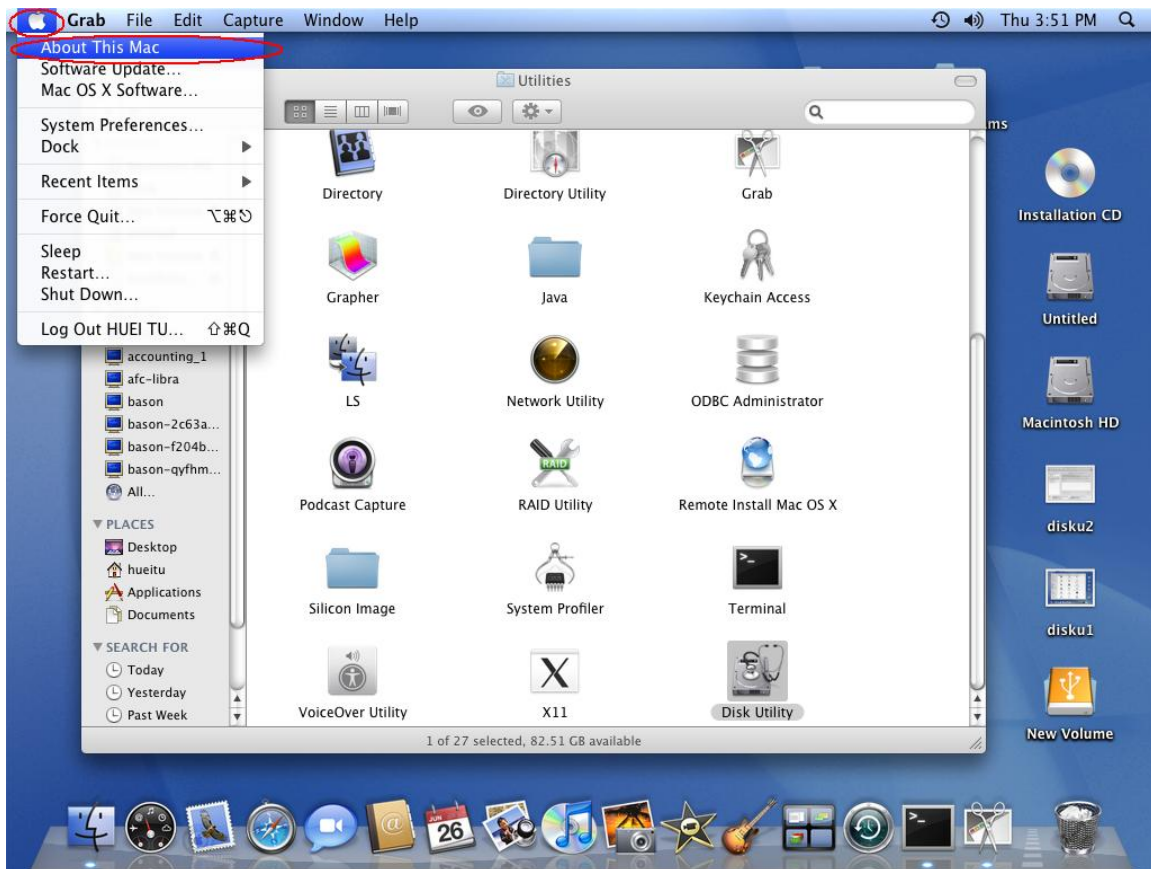




Detecting a Cavalry USB external hard drive in MAC OSX

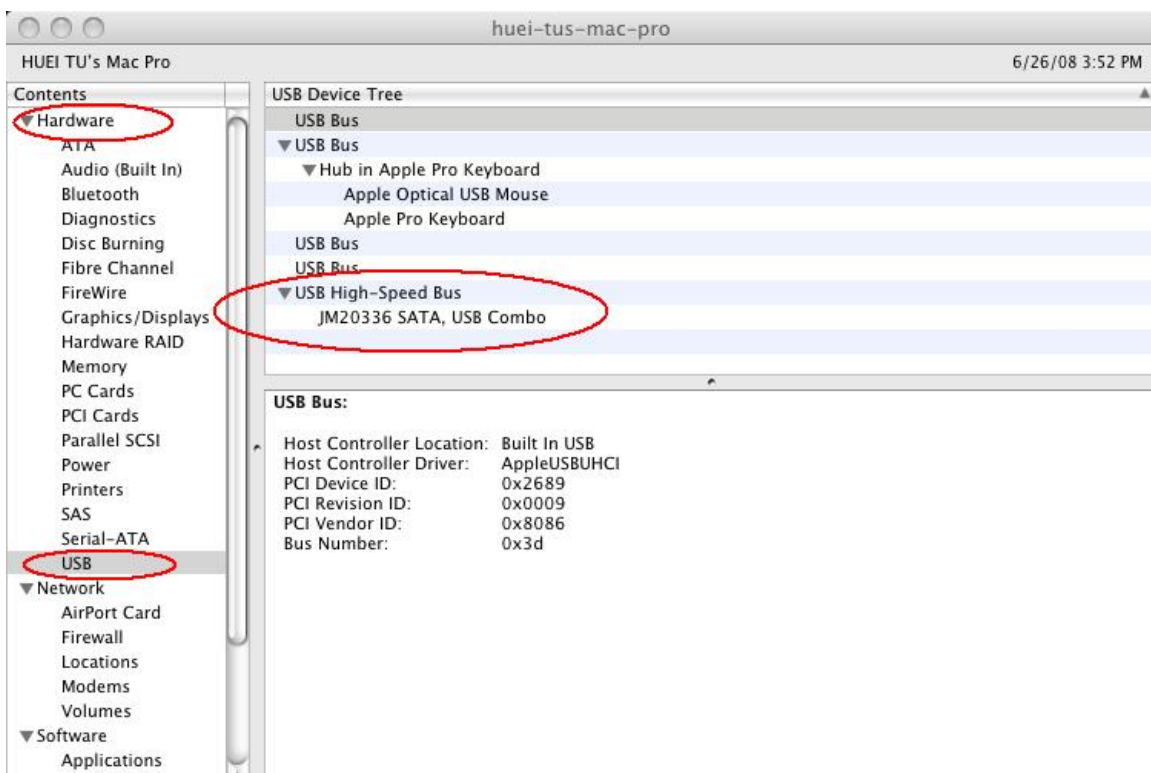
1) Go to the top menu and click on the Apple Icon. Then select "About This Mac".



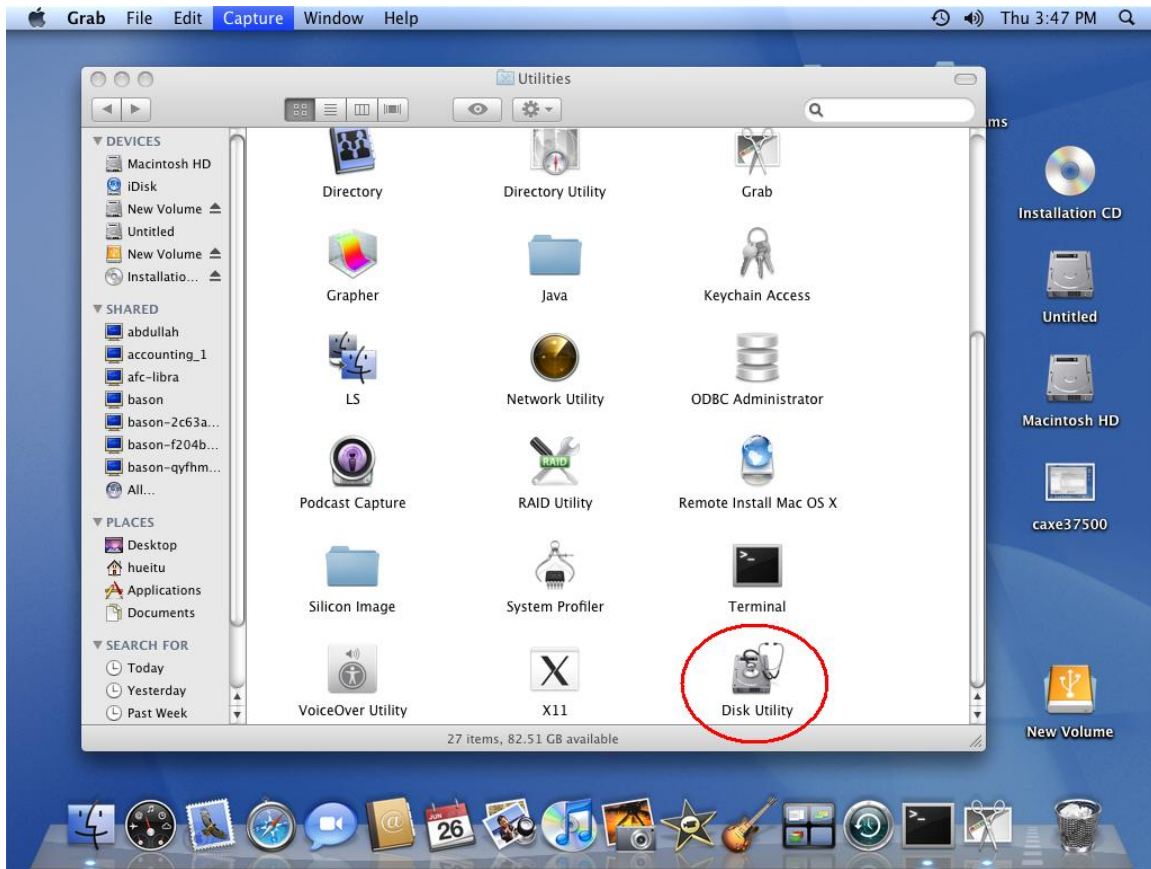
2) You will see the "About This Mac" pop-up window. Click on the button "More Info".



3) The Mac info page will show up. You can expand the "Hardware" header and then click on "USB". On the right pane, you can see your external hard drive listed.



4) You can also see the external drive listed in "Disk Utility". Click on the top-menu item "Utilities". The Utilities window will open up. Double-click on the icon "Disk Utility"



5) Now click on the header at the left that corresponds with your drive. The header will list the physical size of the drive. Listed underneath this will be the formatted volumes, if any, on the drive. At the bottom of the window is information about your external hard drive.
